The undersigned action as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation;

## ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is Southbay Homeowners' Association of Escambia County, Inc., a non-profit corporation, and the address of the corporation is 8900 U.S. Highway 98 West, Post Office Box 3256, Pensacola, Florida 32516.

## ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing upon the date of subscription and acknowledgement of these articles of incorporation.

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation is to form an association of homeowners living within Southbay, to preserve the residential quality of the land for themselves and for future owners and to provide for the maintenance of common areas in Southbay together with any other activity permitted for a not for profit corporation under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the organization shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation and in the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Southbay, together with any amendments thereto, duly recorded in the public records of Escambia County, Florida.

Every Owner of a lot which is subject to assessment shall be a member of the corporation. Membership is appurtenant to, and inseparable from, ownership of a lot.

The corporation shall have two classes of voting membership:

Class A.: Class A members shall be the Owners with the exception of the Developer. Each Class A member shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each lot owned in Southbay.

Class B.: Class B members shall be the Developer who shall be entitled to three

(3) votes for each lot owned. Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership when the total votes outstanding in the Class B membership or on January 1, 1999, whichever occurs earlier.

So long as there is a Class B membership, annexation of additional properties, mergers and consolidations, mortgaging of common areas, dedication of common areas, dissolution and amendment of the Articles of the incorporation require the prior approval of FHA/VA.

#### ARTICLE V - AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the

shareholders is subject to this reservation upon the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the existing lot owners.
